#### Make 2017 the Year You Read the Bible Bryan Bickford

It's the best thing you can do to grow in your walk with God. If you want to grow in your relationship with God, there's one thing you can do that will make more difference than anything. Read the Bible. Here's why:

Research shows that someone who reads the Bible 4 or more times each week is:

22% more likely to share their faith

40% more likely to memorize scripture

59% less likely to view pornography

30% less likely to struggle with loneliness

A person who reads the Bible will have a life that looks different from one who doesn't—even as a Christian. Perhaps this is why Peter wrote: "Therefore, putting aside all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation, if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord" (1 Peter 2:1-3).

Reading the Word of God is how we can taste the "kindness of our Lord," it is through His Word that we find forgiveness. Jesus said, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him." (John 14:23). Jesus cannot make it any clearer! For us to do what He wants, we must read and study His Word.

If you have read the Bible, read it again and again! No matter how many times you read God's Word, there's always more you will learn each time you read it. We have an inexhaustible text.
