

Nothing is Hid from God George Parsley

No matter how much people may try to shove in their spiritual closet, it can not be hid from God. God sees all things, even the things we may try to hide in our closets that nobody else may see.

"And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account" (Heb. 4:13). Along with, "The LORD looks down from heaven; he sees all the children of man; 14 from where he sits enthroned he looks out on all the inhabitants of the earth, 15 he who fashions the hearts of them all and observes all their deeds" (Ps. 33:13-15).

So you see, we can not get away with anything. There is no room so dark or place so far away that the Lord can not see clearly what we are doing. Everything that we do is as if we are doing them literally right in front of the throne of God.

We have a very powerful example of this in the book of Joshua. After they had taken Jericho they had attacked the city of Ai but in the process thirty six men of the Israelites had been killed (Josh. 6:5).

The loss of life was a result of hidden sin in the camp. As Joshua was crying out to God and could not understand why this had happened, the Lord said, "Israel has sinned; they have transgressed my covenant that I commanded them; they have taken some of the devoted things; they have stolen and lied and put them among their own belongings. 12 Therefore the people of Israel cannot stand before their enemies. They turn their backs before their enemies, because they have become devoted for destruction. I will be with you no more, unless you destroy the devoted things from among you" (Josh. 7:11-12).

Not only did the Lord know they had sinned but He knew exactly what they had done. And as result they no longer had His help. A very powerful lesson for us, when we willfully sin and try to hide it then we no longer have the Lords' help.

God knew exactly who had done this also. As Joshua worked his way through the tribe of Judah, the family of the Zarhites and ending with the household of Achan the sin and the sinner was made known (Josh. 7:16-23).

Notice what happened to Achan and his family because of his sin, "And Joshua and all Israel with him took Achan the son of Zerah, and the silver and the cloak and the bar of gold, and his sons and daughters and his oxen and donkeys and sheep and his tent and all that he had. And they brought them up to the Valley of Achor. 25 And Joshua said, "Why did you bring trouble on us? The LORD brings trouble on you today." And all Israel stoned him with stones. They burned them with fire and stoned them with stones" (Josh. 7:24-25).

What a powerful lesson for us all! No sin can be hid from God and that sin could not only cost us our spiritual lives but also that of our families! Yes even his children lost their lives because of his sin. "But if you will not do so, behold, you have sinned against the LORD, and be sure your sin will find you out" (Num. 32:23).
