

- Jesus could not be hid while He lived on earth.
 - Large crowds would look for Him to be healed. Matt. 4:23-25
 - When He finished the sermon on the mount,
 an even larger crowd sought for Him.
 Matt. 8:1
 - There was a point where He could not even enter cities. *Mark* 1:40-45

- Jesus could not be hid in the lives of early Christians.
 - Peter and John. Acts 4:13
 - Barnabas and other Christians.
 Acts 4:34-37; 1 John 3:17-18
 - Paul. Gal. 2:20; 6:17; Phil. 1:21

- Jesus also cannot be hid in the lives of many present day Christians.
 - Just in the same way that quality perfume fills everywhere. John 12:1-3
 - The fruits of the Spirit are also evident. Gal. 5:22-25
 - We must continue to add to our faith.
 2 Pet. 1:5-8

- Ways in which Jesus can be hid in our lives today:
 - When we fail to allow His word to bear fruit.
 Col. 3:16a; Luke 8:11-15
 - When there are quarrels. James 4:1; 1 Cor. 3:3
 - When we continue with worldly behaviors.

 Eph. 4:17-21
 - When our light is to dim. Matt. 5:14-16
