Then those who gladly received his word were <u>baptized</u>; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.












And now why are you waiting? Arise and be <u>baptized</u>, and <u>wash away your sins</u>, calling on the name of the Lord.




