Realized Eschatology The 70 a.D. Doctrine

- The main doctrines of Realized Eschatology:
 - The second coming of Christ...
 - The resurrection of the dead...
 - The day of judgment...
 - The end of the world...
 - All <u>happened</u> in 70 a.D. when Jerusalem was destroyed by the Romans



- Concerning the resurrection from the dead:
 - → The promoters of the 70 a.D. doctrine believe that the resurrection occurred at the destruction of Jerusalem in a spiritual sense. But notice 1 Cor. 15:13-19
 - **○** This false doctrine nothing new. 2 Tim. 2:16-18
 - But Jesus taught that the resurrection was a bodily resurrection. John 5:28-29; 6:40, 44, 54
 - Paul preached an actual resurrection, not a fictional one. Acts 24:14-15

- Concerning the resurrection from the dead:
 - This will happen on the last day, together with the judgment. John 11:23-24; 12:48
 - The apostle Paul left the best treatise on the resurrection in 1 Cor. 15. vs. 35-44
 - Our hope is that this body with its pains and aches will be changed for one without them. 2 Cor. 5:1-5

- The judgment day.
 - The judgment of Christ will occur when Jesus comes back. Matt. 25:31-32
 - The 70 a.D. doctrine says that the judgment refers to judgment on the Jewish nation when Jerusalem was destroyed by the Romans.
 - It's true that in certain places, judgment has to do with a specific nation. Jer. 48:47
 - But at the judgment of Christ all nations will be there.
 Matt. 12:41, 42; 25:31-32

- The judgment day.
 - Paul preached a judgment to come. Acts 24:25
 - Why would Felix be afraid of the judgment if it was a judgment for the Jews?
 - Paul taught that all men should repent because of the judgment to come. Acts 17:30-31
 - Everyone will stand before Christ in judgment. Rom. 14:10; 2 Cor. 5:10
