Realized Eschatology

- The main doctrines of Realized Eschatology:
 - The second coming of Christ...
 - The resurrection of the dead...
 - The day of judgment...
 - The end of the world...
 - All *happened* in 70 a.D. when Jerusalem was destroyed by the Romans



Realized Eschatology

- **The end of the world.**
 - Those who hold the 70 a.D. doctrine claim that the end of the world occurred when the Romans destroyed Jerusalem and the Temple in 70 a.D.
 - Seems that this is based on a misunderstanding of: ***Matt. 24:1-3, 4***

Realized Eschatology

- **The end of the world.**
 - Notice the parallel passages for a better understanding. *Mark 13:1-4; Luke 21:5-7*
 - Their question had to do with the destruction of the Temple!
 - If the end of the world occurred in 70 a.D., what do we do with: *2 Pet. 3:1-13*

Realized Eschatology

- Consequences of such doctrine:

- If the resurrection already occurred, then no one can scripturally marry, and no one should be able to die. *Luke 20:33-36*
- We could not scripturally partake of the Lord's Supper. *1 Cor. 11:23-26*
- We are waiting for nothing to occur, no transformation unto His glory. *Phil. 3:20-21*
