
# Realized Eschatology The 70 a.D. Doctrine

- The main doctrines of Realized Eschatology:
  - The second coming of Christ...
  - The resurrection of the dead...
  - The day of judgment...
  - The end of the world...
  - All <u>happened</u> in 70 a.D. when Jerusalem was destroyed by the Romans



- The end of the world.
  - Those who hold the 70 a.D. doctrine claim that the end of the world occurred when the Romans destroyed Jerusalem and the Temple in 70 a.D.
  - Seems that this is based on a misunderstanding of: Matt. 24:1-3, 4

- The end of the world.
  - Notice the parallel passages for a better understanding. Mark 13:1-4; Luke 21:5-7
    - Their question had to do with the destruction of the Temple!
  - If the end of the world occurred in 70 a.D., what do we do with: 2 Pet. 3:1-13

- Consequences of such doctrine:
  - If the resurrection already occurred, then no one can scripturally marry, and no one should be able to die. Luke 20:33-36
  - We could not scripturally partake of the Lord's Supper. 1 Cor. 11:23-26
  - We are waiting for nothing to occur, no transformation unto His glory. Phil. 3:20-21
