BEATITUDES

Blessed Are The Poor In Spirit, For Theirs Is The Kingdom Of Heaven

Matt. 5:3

- The sermon on the mount.
 - Moses had gone up the mountain to receive the law, Jesus preaches from the mountain the true spirit of the law.
 - The beatitudes are characteristics that differentiate the children of God from the rest.
 - These do not describe 8 types of people, but every follower of Christ must manifest these characteristics.

 - This is the response of Jesus to the teachings of religious leaders of the day:
 - The Zealot's attitude was "don't worry about your spiritual life, our hope is in our military might"

 - The Sadducee's attitude was "we can only survive by compromising with the world, so negotiate the best bargain you can"

- Why the beatitudes?
 - These are not a Christian version of the 10 Commandments.
 - —This is the response of Jesus to the teachings of religious leaders of the day:
 - The Pharisee's attitude was "live a clean, ritually pure life and trust in God, He will do the rest"

- Why the beatitudes?
 - Jesus offered the people the true solution.
 - He did not say "live like this and you will be my disciple"
 - But His sermon presented the idea of "if you are my disciple, then live like this"
 - With the beatitudes, Jesus shows that happiness does not depend on outward circumstances. Luke 12:15

- Blessed are the poor in spirit.
 - Not financially poor, no inherit value in that. *Prov. 30:7-9*
 - Poor can be just as evil as the rich, rich can be just as faithful as the poor. *Matt.* 18:23-34 vs. Gen. 13:2
 - Nor is He talking about being poor-spirited. Titus 1:15

- What does poor in spirit mean?
 - It is to recognize we are empty and have nothing to offer to God. Ps. 8:3-4 Cf. Luke 18:9-14
 - This Pharisee seemed to think that God was lucky he was on His side!
 - Paul on the other hand placed no confidence in self, but in Christ. 2 Cor. 4:5; Phil. 1:21a
 - It is to understand that we cannot direct ourselves, that we depend on the Lord. *Jer.* 10:23; *John* 15:5 *Exam. Matt.* 15:22-28

Blessed Are The Poor In Spirit... Matt. 5:3

- For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
 - Not a future kingdom, but the kingdom of God is composed of such. Matt. 11:11; Matt. 18:3-4
 - The poor in spirit will be the servants of others. *Phil. 2:3-8; John 13:34-35*
 - -The kingdom is the consequence of, not the reward for, being poor in spirit. *Isa.* 57:15; 66:2; James 4:6; 10
