  - This is a commandment from God. 2 Cor. 12:14b

  - We are to take a stand, be in charge, be a parent. Josh 24:14-15

- Our duties towards our children:
  - Involved in serving God and instructing them, is attending every assembly possible. *Psa. 78:5-8*
  - Having them grow up to be faithful Christians will not be by accident. 2 Tim. 1:5; 3:14-15

### **Children Are A Gift Of The Lord**

#### **Psalms 127:3-5**

- Our duties towards our children:
  - At times, instruction requires discipline.
  - Discipline must occur promptly. Prov. 19:18
  - Such discipline is out of love. *Prov.* 13:24
  - Much is said in Proverbs about disciplining our children. Prov. 22:15; 23:13-14; 29:17
  - The seriousness of discipline is seen in the O.T. law. Deut 21:18-21
