Blessed Are The Gentle, For They Shall Inherit The Earth Marth. 5:5

- What it means to be gentle (meek)?
 - It must not be confused with weakness.
 - Moses was very meek, but not weak.
 Num. 12:3, 5-13, 14-15
 - Jesus was meek, but had power to destroy.
 1 Pet. 2:23, Matt. 26:51-53
 - Every Christian is to be a meek, self-controlled person. *Prov.* 16:32; 25:28

- Who are the gentle (meek)?
 - The psalmist gives the answer. Ps. 37:1-11
 - It is the person who humbles himself before mighty God.
 - Even when facing adversity. Job 1:21
 - Even when serving God requires sacrifice. Gen. 22:1-3
 - Even when being chastened by the Lord.
 Heb. 12:5-6

- Who are the gentle (meek)?
 - Meekness is also shown in our dealings with fellow man. *Titus 3:1-2*
 - Treat all men with kindness. Matt. 5:43-47; Rom. 12:17-21
 - Be patient even when wronged. 1 Cor. 6:7
 - When restoring the erring. Gal. 6:1; 2 Tim. 2:24-26

- The result: "they shall inherit the earth"
 - Land? Oil wells? Houses?
 - No, but if we belong to Christ, all things belong to us. 1 Cor. 3:21-23
 - Means to be blessed by God in this present life.
 Ps. 25:8-13; 37:9
 - It means to enjoy to the fullest this life, even if we own nothing. *Phil.* 4:11-13
