 - World urges to get all the pleasure out of life, that is where comfort is found.
 - Even David looked for comfort away from his troubles.
 Ps. 55:6-8
 - But comfort was found in God.

- What does it mean to mourn?
 - Greek word means "to bewail, lament, mourn for" cf. Gen. 37:33-35
 - But not all who mourn are blessed:
 - No blessing for the pessimist.
 Exo. 14:10-12; Num. 13:25-33; Heb. 3:16-19
 - No blessing for the self-pitiers.
 1 Kings 19:2-4; Heb. 12:16-17
 - No blessing for those with an injured pride.
 - 1 Sam. 18:6-9

- What does it mean to mourn?
 - Greek word means "to bewail, lament, mourn for" cf. Gen. 37:33-35
 - But not all who mourn are blessed:
 - No blessing for those who mourn material loss. *Eccl.* 5:13-16
 - No blessing for those who mourn the consequence of their sin. 2 Cor. 7:8-10

Matt. 5:4

- What does it mean to mourn?
 - Greek word means "to bewail, lament, mourn for" cf. Gen. 37:33-35
 - Mourners that are blessed:
 - Those who mourn over their own sins. Ps. 51:2-4, 17; Joel 2:12-13; James 4:8-10
 - Those who mourn over the sins of others. *Phil. 3:18; 1 Cor. 5:2*
 - Those who mourn with others.
 Rom. 12:15; John 11:33-35

Blessed Are Those Who Mourn... Matt. 5:4

- The effect of such morning: "they shall be comforted"
 - -Comfort in knowing our sins are forgiven. Isa. 61:1-3; Ps. 32:1-2; 2 Sam. 12:13
 - -Joy in seeing others come to Jesus. *Gal. 6:1; James 5:19-20*
 - -Joy in alleviating the pain of others. *Gal. 6:2; Acts 20:35*
 - -The comfort of heaven. Ps. 30:4-5; Rev. 21:3-4
