


- Dinosaurs and the bible:
 - You cannot find the word dinosaur in the bible and there is a reason for that:
 - The word "dinosaur" did not enter the lexicon of modern languages until 1841.
 - At this time, a famous British scientist, Dr. Richard Owen, coined the name "Dinosauria," meaning "terrible lizard"

- Dinosaurs and the bible:
 - The word dinosaur derives from two greek words: (deinos) "terrible, powerful, wondrous" (sauros) "lizard".





- What were dinosaurs called before 1841?
 - There is a Hebrew word (tanniyn) that is generic, and refers to great animals created by God that dwelled with man. Gen. 1:21; Isa. 27:1; Jer. 51:34; Eze. 29:3
 - Also there is a Hebrew word that refers to a specific animal that it's description is what we call a "dinosaur" Job 40:15-24
 - A third Hebrew word that also describes a great sea animal that fits the description of a "dinosaur" Job 41:1-2; Isa. 27:1

This fossil footprint was found in July of 2000 by amateur archaeologist, Awis Delk of Stephenville, Texas and is now on display at the Creation Evidence Museum, Glen Rose, TX. Mr. Delk found the loose slab against the bank of the Paluxy River, about one mile north of **Dinosaur Valley State Park.**
