
# The Conversion Of The Three Thousand <u>Acts 2</u>


- The details of this occasion:
  - The day: Pentecost.
    - Greek word that means "fiftieth day", called "feast of weeks" in the O.T. Lev. 23:15-16
  - **The city: Jerusalem.** 
    - Ancient city of the Jebusites, also called "Salem" in O.T. Gen. 14:18
    - City later was completely captured by David.
      2 Sam. 5:6-10




- The details of this occasion:
  - The place: the Jewish Temple.
    - Remodeled by Herod the Great, completed in 64 A.D. just 6 years before it's destruction.

#### **Herod's Temple**

King Herod the Great began renovations on the Second Temple approximately 20-19 BC The entire temple wasn't completed until approximately 62-64 AD, only to be destroyed by the Romans in 70 AD.






