- Some believe the end justifies the means!

Growth

- Here is an interesting fact: We have Biblical commands for soundness, peace, and accomplishment, yet none at all for numerical growth!
- But we do have a command for spiritual growth.
 - 2 Peter 3:18

"...Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him belongs glory now and forever."

2 Peter 3:18, CEB

Growth

Does this mean that numerical growth is not important? Not at all!

Acts 2:41; 4:4

- The principle of "Divine Subtraction!"

 Acts 5:1-11
- Numerical growth will take care of itself when all other things are in their proper place ... then the glory belongs to God!

1 Corinthians 3:6

"I planted, Apollos watered, but God made it grow."

1 Corinthians 3:6, CEB

Growth

If local churches make numerical growth their number one priority, sooner or later doctrinal soundness is sacrificed!
