


- Not By His Appearance (2 Cor. 11:13-14)




Beautiful Christians

A Growing Church Is Not Just Personal Evangelism

- They were a praying people (Acts 2:41-41, 3:1; 4:24)
- They were a problem solving people (Acts 6; 15:4-6)
- They were a people in which women played a major role: Lydia (16), Priscilla (18), Paul arrested men and women
- Women did not "teach nor usurp authority over a man" (1 Tim. 2:12); but 8 or more women labored in the Lord (Rom. 16:1-15)

A Growing Church Is Not Just Personal Evangelism

- They were a sacrificial people (Acts 2:42-44; 4:34-35)
- They were a people steadfast in the midst of trials and persecutions – "They ceased not"
- We must be willing to suffer hardship and not expect that life in Christ will always be comfortable and convenient.

A Growing Church Is Not Just Personal Evangelism

- They were a people who loved one another (Acts 20:36-38).
- They were a people seeking truth (Acts 2:42).
- They were a people who spread the good news (Acts 8:4).
