




A study of the book of Jude

- Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:
 - False teachers distort God's truths (vs. 4)
 - They turn His truth into groundless and mistaken principles.
 - Cf. Ps. 50:21; Rom. 1:25a; Isa. 55:8-9
 - The false teacher will disregard accepted rules and standards.

Cf. Deut. 27:17; 25:13-16; Matt. 23:2-5a; Rom. 10:2-3



- Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:
 - False teachers reject Jesus' authorized teachings (vs. 4)
 - In doing so, they deny Him in the process. Luke 6:46; Matt. 24:4-5; Col. 2:8
 - They will claim to follow the Lord, but their teachings will add to His word, thus denying Him. 1 Tim. 6:3-5, 20-21; 2 Pet. 2:1-3; Titus 1:14b; 2 John 9-11



Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:

 They lose sight of God's gracious promises (vs. 5)

• False teachers take matters into their own hands, akin to those who came out of Egypt. Num. 14:1-4

cf. 1 Cor. 1:18-20; Heb. 3:12-19

Instead, we are to rely on God's time.
