Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:

 False teachers deny authority figures (vs. 8b)


Such as church elders, and most importantly, the Lord, rejecting orders and commands. cf. Num. 16:1-3, 8-11, 16-21, 31-33; 1 Sam. 8:7; 1 Tim. 4:11-12; Titus 2:15

They freely speak against those in positions of authority. 1 Kings 18:16-18;
 1 Kings 22:1-5, 15-18; cf. Acts 23:1-5

- Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:
  - They fall into the game of the devil. (vs. 9)
    - They do not separate themselves and resist the devil. John 8:44; Gen. 3:1-6;
       2 Cor. 2:11; 11:3; 1 Pet. 5:8-9; James 4:7
    - Rather, false teachers allow the wicked one to have his way with them.

Eph. 4:26-27; Luke 4:1-13; 1 Cor. 10:13;

1 John 3:8; Eph. 6:10-13




Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:

 False teachers reject the things that they do not understand. (vs. 10)

These individuals are likened to animals.
 Cf. Isa. 1:2-3; Job 12:7-10; Jer. 8:7;
 Prov. 6:6-8

 Doing things simply because it seems good to them. Cf. 2 Pet. 2:12-16; Ps. 147:9-11; Isa. 55:8-9; Acts 26:9
