Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:

 He now compares false teachers to very wicked individuals, Cain (vs. 11)

• He illustrates how they reveal themselves through their attitude toward truth and righteousness.

Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:

 He now compares false teachers to very wicked individuals, Balaam (vs. 11)

• He highlights their love for things other than God's word. Num. 24:1, 10; 31:16; Rev. 2:14; 2 Peter 2:15 cf. John 12:42-43

• They place stumbling blocks before God's people with their erroneous teachings. *Matt.* 16:21-23; 18:6-7 cf. 1 Cor. 10:32-33; James 5:19-20



- Jude dissects all parts of a false teacher:
  - He now compares false teachers to very wicked individuals, Korah (vs. 11)
    - False teachers will go against God's designation and established order.
       Num. 16:1-3; 3:27-32 cf. Rom. 12:3-5; Eph. 4:11-16
    - They will contradict and twist God's holy word to suit their preferences.
       2 Pet. 3:14-16; 1 Tim. 1:5-7; Acts 13:44-45
