 - A good leader is a good example. Phil. 2:5-8; Luke 22:24-27
 - A good leader is a good listener.
 James 1:19-20
 - Great danger when the husband does not do a good job as a leader. 1 Sam. 2:22-25

- A good leader will keep his home from the things that can destroy it.
 - In-law problems.
