

- The religious world today is divided...
 - But this does not come from God. 1 Cor. 1:10, 13q
 - Many will be rejected for not walking by God's standard. Matt. 7:21-23
 - Jesus only recognizes two sources of authority:
 Matt. 21:23-27
 - How can we know if our faith and practice is from heaven?

- In order to be from heaven it must originate with God.
 - God is the source of all truth. James 1:17-18;
 John 17:17; Rom. 3:4; 2 Tim. 2:15
 - We are under the authority of the new law.
 Col. 2:13-17; Heb. 10:8-10
 - All things are under the subjection of Christ.
 Matt. 28:18

- To be from heaven it must come through Christ and His apostles:
 - To reject Jesus is to reject God. 1 John 2:23
 - To hear Jesus is to hear God. John 12:49
 - To receive the apostles is to receive Christ. Matt. 10:40
 - To reject the apostles is to reject Christ and the Father. 1 John 4:6

- In order to be from heaven it must be recorded in the N.T.
 - The apostles revelation from heaven was written for future generations. 2 Pet. 3:1-2, 1:20-21;
 Eph. 3:3-5; 1 Tim. 5:18
 - Any worship offered without authority is useless.
 Matt. 15:8-9
