

- She must be in subjection to her husband.
 - This subjection was established from the beginning. Gen. 3:16
 - This subjection must be as to the Lord. Eph. 5:22
 - This subjection must be in everything. Eph. 5:23-24
 - This subjection must be even to unbelieving husbands.
 1 Pet. 3:1-2
 - This subjection is fitting in the Lord. Col. 3:17-18

- She must truly be a "helper suitable". Gen. 2:18-24
 - Being a "helper suitable" requires compatibility, suitable to where her husband lacks. *Prov.* 18:22
 - She helps with the needs of the home:
 - Being keeper of her home. Titus 2:3-5
 - Managing the house. 1 Tim. 5:11-15
 - With the physical needs of the marriage. 1 Cor. 7:1-4
 - Raising children. Prov. 31:27-29

- She must truly be a "helper suitable". Gen. 2:18-24
 - She also is a helper suitable in the spiritual realm.
 - Being an example of faithfulness.
 - 1 Pet. 3:1-6
 - Being an influence for salvation.
 - 1 Cor. 7:16

- Truly loves her husband. Titus 2:3-4
 - This love is not simply based on physical attraction.
 1 Cor. 13:4-8a
 - This love must be cultivated and expressed continually.
 - This love is based on respect. Eph. 5:28-33
 - A Christian wife loves her husband though he may be full of faults. 1 Pet. 3:6
