# A Beculiar People

1 Peter 2:1-12

"... a people for his [God's] own possession." (ESV; NASB) "... His own special people." (NKJV) "... God's own people." (NRS) Def. = "strange; odd; uncommon; unusual; distinctive in character from others." (Dictionary.com)

"But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light." (1 Peter 2:9, KJV)

#### Why Were They a "Peculiar People?"

- They were *peculiar* because they were a people who belonged to God!
- They were *peculiar* because God has always wanted his people to be <u>different</u> from the world in which they live!
  - 1 Peter 4:3-4
- They were *peculiar* because God wants his people to be <u>separate</u> from the world in which they live!
  - 2 Corinthians 4:14-18

## N.T. Christians Were <u>NOT</u> "Peculiar" in:

- What they ate.
  - 1 Timothy 4:1-5; 1 Corinthians 8:8
- Their physical appearance ... no particular style of dress (assuming it was modest!)
- Their occupations ... how they made a living.
  - Tent-makers
    - Merchants
      - Slaves
        - Etc.
