 - How does He do this? Ps. 41:9-10; 1 Pet. 3:13-14

 - Nothing can separate us from the love of God. Rom. 8:31-37
 - Remember the attitude of Joseph? Gen. 50:20

 - -Afflictions produce hope and a blessing. Rom. 5:3-5; James 1:2-4
